COUNSELORS: We are looking for women trained in counseling, a related field, or have applicable life experiences that have a burden to help women in a crisis pregnancy. Training is provided through Total Life Care Centers in Minneapolis and through the Director at the Center.

CLIENT ADVOCATES: Individuals who offer support and help clients access services available through the Life Care Center

MEDICAL PERSONNEL: Family practice physicians, R.N.'s, L.P.N.'s, and lab technicians for basic non-emergency medical care twice monthly for all people in the community. The medical staff is on a rotating schedule.

PROFESSIONALS: With areas of expertise in parenting, safety, life skills or health to assist in scheduled classes.

In addition to the areas listed above, we are always in need of prayer support, which provides the spiritual under girding for our work.

The need for financial contributions is also constant. We always welcome new baby clothes for our layettes, blankets, disposable and cloth diapers, strollers, cribs, playpens, new car seats, infant formula, and baby food.

TLC Policies

1. Every individual has the right to life and the right to health care from the moment of conception until natural death.
2. Total Life-Care Centers and its affiliates do not perform abortions, nor refer for abortions, but offer alternatives to meet the physical, emotional and financial needs of all concerned to the extent we are able.
3. Abortifacients, sterilization and all artificial birth control methods are incompatible with the TLC philosophy. These shall not be encouraged, provided or dispensed.
4. Natural Family Planning is to be encouraged for married couples seeking family planning advice.
5. No one will be refused services because of inability to pay. At our Center all services are free.
6. Doctors and other medical professionals who are participating with any TLC Center must follow the above policies and practice.
